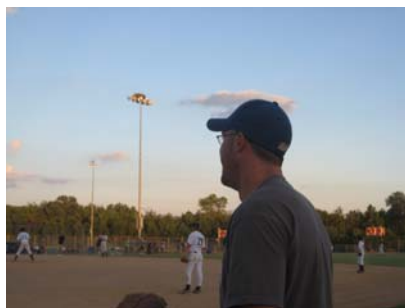


White Hawks made Blue work for runs

Olson led the charge for the White Hawks going 3-3 with a run and RBI. Easley, Smith, and Kern added a pair of hits each with 4 RBIs combined. The winning pitcher was Quinlan Milne-Rojek as he threw two solid innings while giving up only one run on four hits, striking out one.
